The Campbellsville Independent School district is looking forward to welcoming our students back to a five day a week in-person instruction model for all our students for the 2021-22 school year. Our main priority has always been and will continue to be the safety and health of our students and staff.

The best prevention strategy for COVID19 is vaccination. We will continue to work with our local public health organizations to provide opportunities for eligible staff and students to be vaccinated

The CDC and the KDPH recommend individuals who have not been vaccinated to wear masks. Students and staff will have an option to wear a mask or not while in the building. This option is available to all students and staff regardless of their vaccination status.

We are required to continue contact tracing and quarantine all exposures concerning COVID-19. Vaccinated individuals will not be quarantined, unless they show symptoms.

Our staff will continue to emphasize proper handwashing, cough etiquette and the use of approved hand sanitizer. We will continue our COVID-19 cleaning treatment of all buildings and buses. An emphasis will be placed on high-touch, high trafficked areas.

An isolation area will be provided for students and staff with COVID-19 symptoms. Individuals with COVID-19 symptoms will be required to wear a mask while waiting to be picked up.

Where and when possible, CISD students will maintain three feet physical distancing. This will not be possible in all settings due to the number of students, building spacing and/or available staff for supervision. We will continue to utilize classroom seating charts to assist with contact tracing and quarantines.

Per the guidance for K-12 School Operations for in-person learning, everyone two years old and older are required to wear a mask while riding a bus, unless otherwise exempted.

Only essential visitors will be allowed access to our schools.

The CISD will continue to work with local health officials to monitor the COVID-19 numbers in our community.
